Warnings:

- Do not use on cats.
- Due to their unique physiology and inability to metabolise certain compounds, this product must not be used on cats. To prevent cats from accidentally being exposed to Advantix[®], keep treated dogs away from cats until the application site is dry. Do not allow cats to groom the site of application on a dog which has been treated with Advantix[®]. Seek veterinary advice immediately if this occurs or if a cat is accidentally treated with Advantix[®].
- In the absence of available data, the product should not be used on puppies of less than 7 weeks of age and 1,5 kg of weight.
